- Change C6.1, remove " Staff";
- Change title of B4 from "Associate Members" to "Other Members"
- Number paragraph of B4 about associate members as B4.1
- Add B4.2:  
"2. College staff may row in bumps races for a college subject to the following restrictions:
  1. The member of staff must be in possession of a valid University ID card listing affiliation to that particular college.
  2. College staff may not be entered in boats which are in Senior Divisions, as defined in rule B2.7, including the Sandwich Boats, at the start of the competition, except in the lowest Senior Division Crew of that college, with permission from a Captains' Meeting.
  3. College staff must be indicated as such on the Entry Form."
