1st VIII rower & Senior cox for 3 years, so understand issues with bumps racing & have **experience** of the safety and **organisational** aspects of bumps racing.

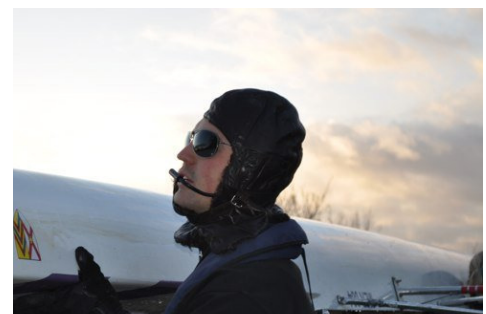
Coach for Merton M1, M2, W1 and W2.
